A minimum unit price for alcohol is recognised as one approach in tackling harm caused by alcohol. ChaMPs has worked closely with the Liverpool City, Cheshire and Warrington region to achieve a minimum unit price for alcohol, and welcomed its inclusion in the new national alcohol strategy in 2012.

Cheshire & Merseyside Task & Finish Group on MUP

In March 2011 a group mandated by both the Cheshire and Warrington Health and Wellbeing Commission and the Liverpool City Region Safer Healthier Communities Board convened to explore the implications of pursuing a local byelaw to introduce a MUP. The group was chaired by Margaret Carney, Chief Executive Officer of Sefton Council. The group also established links with the Association of Greater Manchester Authorities (AGMA) existing Task and Finish group, in order to avoid duplication of effort.
