

Public Health Leadership Programme

NHS North West and the Health and Wellbeing Alliance have developed a leadership programme for middle and senior managers in partnership with North West Employers. The programme will be available to staff working in both the NHS and Local Authorities and will run from February to July with the following aims and outcomes:-

a) To develop public health knowledge and understanding of the public health role in existing leaders who have not had the public health role previously.

b) To develop future leaders from a pool of middle and senior managers who are already working in public health.

NHS Organisations will provide support by

- Ensuring a Champion of the programme who will promote and share good practice and learning
- Offering the programme to appropriate personnel across the organisation
- Providing protected learning time for staff
- Collaborating with selection of appropriate work based learning project
- Providing accommodation for course delivery
- Providing a designated point of contact within each organisation
- Taking part in evaluation and contributing towards a self-sustaining roll out of the programme
