### Cervical Screening

#### NHS Cervical Screening Programme information and guidance notes published

Information and Guidance notes have been published for NHS Cervical Screening programmes these relate to the belated changes to the National Health Application and Infrastructure Service (NHAIS Exeter) system to support screening invitations for women from age 24½ as agreed by the Advisory Committee in 2009.

The NHAIS system has been developed to ensure that women will be sent their first invitation when they are exactly 24 years and 6 months of age. Subsequent invitations will be sent 6 weeks in advance of the test-due date. [Read more here.](#)
