

TRU4 'Re-Tweak' St Helens - Domestic Abuse and risks to teenagers training to professionals

The training programme and model was developed by NHS Wirral and shared at a Cheshire and Merseyside Sexual Health Network meeting to partners.

St Helens Children and Young People's Service and partners are looking to adopt the model for professionals across all disciplines.

As part of the implementation St Helens Teenage Pregnancy Strategy Manger visited a school in Wirral to observe the delivery.

St Helens tweaks:

- We have been able to localise the presentation
- Use a CD ROM resource that has been agreed locally- "Face up" [1]
- Pilot the programme to school based staff
- Adapt the programme to target other professional groups
- Multi-disciplinary delivery team to enable a wider offer of the training programme.
- Discussions with the Local Safeguarding Board (LSGB) Training Manager to adopt training as part of the core offer to all professionals.
