

## TRU4: Training for staff on Teenage Relationship Abuse

**Geographical Area:** Wirral

**Lead Professional/Organisation:** Jayne Price RSE Curriculum and Policy Lead, NHS Wirral

**Brief Overview:** A session for staff which can be delivered as a stand alone or part of a programme of sessions to equip staff to deliver Relationships and Sex Education (RSE).

**Target Group:** Teachers and other school staff.

**Outcomes:** To increase knowledge about Teenage Relationship Abuse.

**Evaluation:** Well evaluated by staff and resource used by schools with positive evaluation. Staff are often surprised at the confusion from young people about what constitutes a respectful relationship, and therefore the need for work in this area.

**Sustainability:** Good-each school has staff trained and the resource is free to download from Bristol Domestic Violence Forum.

**What made it work?** Delivering to teams in their own school as twilight sessions. Informing PSHE lead and Safeguarding Lead of training available.

**What could make it work better?** More staff attending.
