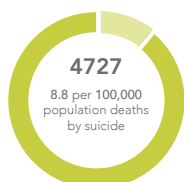


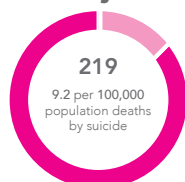

Suicide Deaths in Cheshire & Merseyside



80%

Bereaved family & friends – 3 times more
at risk of taking their own lives

Economic cost each death £1,700,000
Cheshire & Merseyside £372.3 Million each year

Higher risk groups • middle-aged men, people known to mental health services, those with a history of self-harm, previous suicide attempts, bereaved family and friends, people in contact with the criminal justice system.

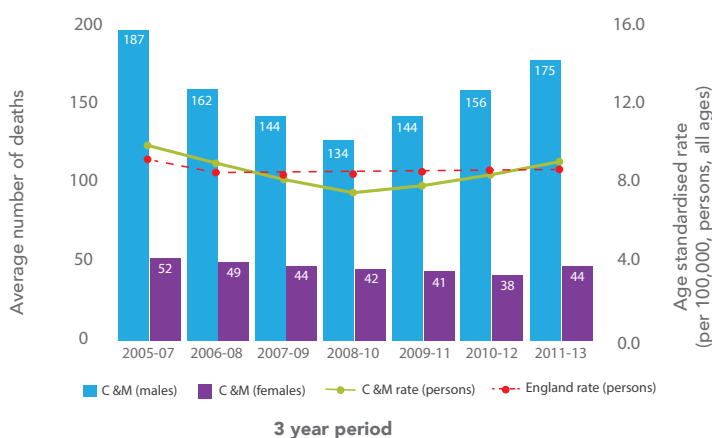
Contact with Mental Health services



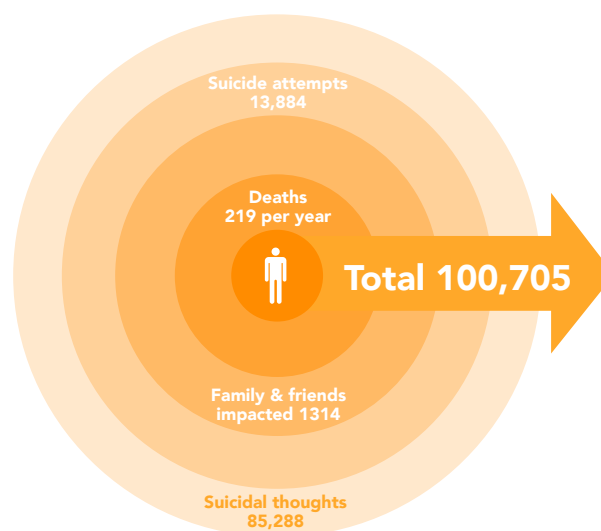
Contacted GP in last month
